- ! Skill building assistance
- ! Family support services including:
 - Respite care

- ! Enhanced health care services
- ! Assistance with challenging behaviors
- ! Other services/supports as determined necessary through the person-center planning process

What Will Be Different? An Operational Paradigm Shift, Coming Right up!

- ! Movement from a Services Reimbursement Model to a Purchase of Outcomes Model
- ! Application of Person-Centered Planning to Achieve Individualized Delineation of Desired Services & Supports
- ! Active Treatment Optional, Not Required
- ! Implementation of the Principles of Self-Determination Through Consumer-Directed and Managed Services/ Supports Arrangements
- ! Elimination of Waiting Lists ("As We Know Them")

10 Keys to Successful Waivers

- ! Accurately define population to be served
- ! Provide for universe of clinical and support services that recognize individual needs
- ! Identify provider qualifications

10 Keys to Successful Waivers

- ! Design an approach of coordination and service delivery that supports independence/interdependence and community integration
- ! Respect unique needs of each individual to protect civil rights and ensure informed choices

10 Keys to Successful Waivers

- ! Recognize and support the role of families, as appropriate
- ! Provide for monitoring and system of oversight
- ! Promote involvement from all stakeholders in the development and implementation of the waiver

10 Keys to Successful Waivers

- ! Ensure the financial integrity of the funds expended
- ! Meet all regulatory and statutory requirements

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
