Practical Focus

- Once housing is found and secured, the housing specialist is the expert on how to make the move.
- Because your tenants may be out of practice with living in their own place, you can offer useful tips and practical assistance.



Practical Focus, cont'd.

Use transition plans. The exercise of working through these tools allows the tenant to come to understand the details of the transition they are making. It helps to get people thinking about what the new situation might be like, and plan ahead for opportunities and problems.



Practical Focus, cont'd. 2

Use checklists and other tools to aid in planning for the move. It is easy to forget things, and nothing takes the excitement out of the first week in a new place like not having a refrigerator (for example).



Practical Focus, cont'd. 3

Focus on the rights and responsibilities of tenancy.
